Definitions: *from Google*

Monochromatic: “one color from the color wheel. Variations are created by adding white (tints), black (shades), or gray (tones) to the base hue.”

Close-up “an image taken from a very short distance, causing the subject to appear large and fill most of the frame.”

Macro – “ the art of extreme close-up photography, capturing tiny subjects—like insects, flowers, or textures—at life-size or greater magnification”

Creative Techniques “artistic methods—such as intentional camera movement, light painting, or unique compositions—used to transcend simple documentation and convey emotion, stories, or, for example, a personal, imaginative vision. They involve manipulating camera settings, lighting, or post processing to create visually compelling non-traditional images.”
