- A portion of the Riverwalk near the Broward Center for the Performing Arts will be closed to pedestrians while crews remove pavers to repair a 72-inch stormwater pipe that runs along SW 5th Avenue.
- The stairs that connect the Riverwalk to the Broward Center for the Performing Arts will be inaccessible.
- A portion of the grassy area within Esplanade Park near SW 5th Avenue will be closed.
- Please follow posted signs and exercise caution in the area.

Since construction began in April 2025, 78 drainage structures and 14,536 feet of stormwater pipe have been installed. Work is typically taking place weekdays between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. This schedule is subject to change based on inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances. Construction is expected to be completed in fall 2026.
