



VICTORIA PARK NEIGHBORHOOD STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working with David Mancini & Sons, Inc. to make improvements to the stormwater system in the Victoria Park neighborhood to enhance its efficiency and reliability.

Traffic Impacts: Feb. 19 – Mar. 13, 2026

Crews will be upgrading stormwater infrastructure along NE 6th Street between NE 9th Avenue and NE 12th Avenue starting Thursday, February 19 through Friday, March 13. Work will take place weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

- NE 6th Street will be open to local traffic only between NE 9th Avenue and NE 12th Avenue.
- Traffic will be detoured to NE 9th Avenue, NE 5th Street and NE 12th Avenue.
- Access to driveways and homes will be maintained.
- Please follow posted signs and drive with caution in the area.
- NE 6th Street will reopen to traffic during non-work hours whenever possible.



Construction began on January 5, 2026, and is expected to be completed in early 2028. This schedule is subject to change based on inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
