



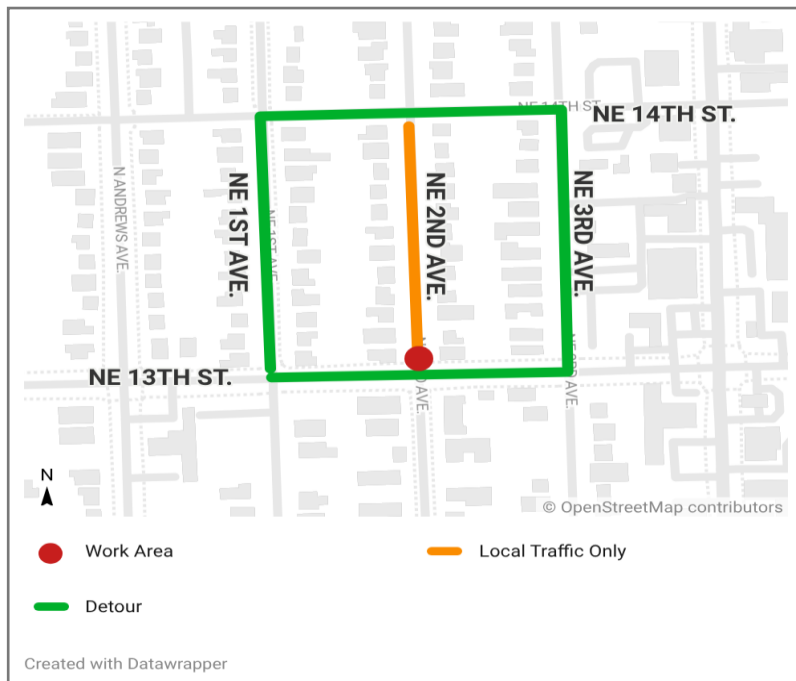
CITYWIDE STORMWATER PIPE REPLACEMENT PROJECT: SOUTH MIDDLE RIVER AND MIDDLE RIVER TERRACE

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working with DP Development to replace existing stormwater pipes that were damaged during the April 2023 flood event.

Traffic Impacts: February 16-18, 2026

Crews will be replacing a stormwater pipe along NE 2nd Avenue on the north side of the NE 13th Street intersection in South Middle River starting Monday, February 16, through Wednesday, February 18. Work will take place daily between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.

- NE 2nd Avenue will be open to local traffic only between NE 14th Street and NE 13th Street.
- Traffic will be detoured to NE 1st Avenue, NE 14th Street, NE 3rd Avenue and NE 13th Street.
- One westbound lane of NE 13th Street at NE 2nd Avenue will be closed. One westbound lane will remain open.
- Access to driveways and homes will be maintained.
- Please follow posted signs and drive with caution in the area.
- NE 2nd Avenue will reopen to traffic during non-work hours whenever possible.



Construction on this stormwater pipe replacement project in South Middle River and Middle River Terrace began on Monday, January 5, 2026, and is expected to be completed in spring 2026. This schedule is subject to change based on inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
