



Beverly Yacht Club Junior Sailing COVID-19 Policy's

Summary

1. Before You Arrive
 - a. Submit daily screening form 1 hour before sailors class.
 - b. Self screen anyone coming to the club to drop of the sailor.
 - c. Ensure sailor has all gear including: BUFF, life jacket, and water bottle.
 - d. Apply SPF 30 or great sun screen.
2. When you arrive
 - a. Check in at stone wall.
 - b. Sailors will wash their hands before entering jr. program area.
 - c. Sailors will stow all equipment in assigned cubby and head to class.
3. Pick-Up
 - a. Sign sailor out of sailing at the pick up point by the junior clubhouse.

Screening

- In compliance with the Massachusetts Department of Early Education and Care all sailors will be screened daily for signs, symptoms and exposure to COVID-19.
- Parents will receive an email each morning with a link to a Google Form that must be filled out at least 1 hour before the start of class.
- All screening surveys will be reviewed by a health care supervisor.
- Screening **must** be complete before any sailor will be allowed on the premises.
- Any one dropping a sailor off at the club must also self-screen using the questions above prior to arriving at the Yacht Club.
- Sailors with an incomplete daily screening will not be allowed on BYC premises until the screening has been completed and then reviewed by the health care supervisor.

Getting Ready for Sailing

- Before you drop your sailor off please ensure that they have the following items:
 - Life Jacket (USCG Approved PFD)- due to COVID policies there will be **no loaner lifejackets**. Any sailor who arrives without a lifejacket will be unable to participate in sailing activities.
 - Closed Toe Shoes.
 - Full Water Bottle- there will be no water fountain or water bubbler available for sailor use at the club.
 - Sun Protection- all sailors must apply SPF 30 or higher sunscreen before arriving at the club. Due to COVID policies we will be unable to provide sailors with sunscreen. Sunglasses, hats and long-sleeve shirts are highly recommended.
 - Towel and a change of clothes.
 - BUFF (Extra BUFF Recommended).
 - We recommend a buff for a face covering. Buffs can be worn pulled down around the neck while sailing for easy access when social distancing is not possible.
 - Sailors must arrive at sailing wearing a clean buff each day.
 - Face coverings should be clearly marked with your child's name and clearly distinguish which side of the covering should be worn facing outwards, so they are worn properly each day.
 - The buff must be washed after each day of sailing. If possible, face coverings should be washed in a washing machine in hot water and dried fully before using again. If a washing machine is unavailable, masks must be washed with soap and hot water and allowed to dry fully before using again.
 - We recommend sailors bring a backup face covering in case there's becomes wet or soiled.

- All sailor belongings must be labeled with the sailor's name.
- All sailor belongings should be packed into a waterproof bag.

Drop Off/Check- In

- Check-In and will take place by the Stone Wall on Water St., all sailors must Check-In before proceeding to the Junior Program Area.
- All sailors **must** be signed into sailing each day by a designated “Trusted Contact” on their CampDoc’s Profile.
- To be a “Trusted Contacts” please upload an easily recognizable photo of the individual to CampDoc’s system.
- Sailors age 10 and older may be designated as their own “Trusted Contact” to do so please add them to their CampDoc’s Profile.
- Sailors age 10 and older may be designated as a “Trusted Contact” for their younger sibling.
- Parents who wish to get out of their car for any reason please park on Water, South or Main St. and walk their sailor to the stone wall.
- Parents may also pull up to the stone wall for drop-off, please check your sailor in with a staff member before driving away! Please refrain from getting out of the car to keep things moving swiftly.
- Sailors will be required to wear a face covering and maintain a distance of at least 6 ft. at all times during check-in.
- Once checked in, sailors will be directed to wash their hands before entering the Junior Program area and placing their belongings in their assigned cubby.
- All Sailors will be assigned a cubby for their use for the duration of the session.
- All Sailor belongings should be with the sailor or in their cubby at all times.
- No one but Junior Sailing Participants and Staff will be allowed in the Jr. Sailing area.

Pick Up and Sign-Out

- All sailors must be signed out by a Trusted Contact before they can leave the sailing area.
- Parents of sailors under 10, or those who have not designated their sailor as their own trusted contact are asked to park and come to the Sign-Out point by the Junior Clubhouse.
- Before you leave BYC please ensure you have all of your sailors belongings, nothing should be left in sailor cubbies overnight.

Please keep in mind that all travelers arriving in Massachusetts are instructed to self-quarantine for 14 days.
