

Helping Our Community!

ACTS has continuously served our community since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, meeting the urgent needs of our clients. Thanks to the generous support of our donors and partners, we continue to provide critical services in the form of Food, Utility Assistance, Medical Assistance and other services to prevent additional hardships. Our Transportation Program has resumed operations providing used cars and bicycles to qualified adults who have unreliable or no transportation.

We have modified our service delivery procedures to ensure the safety of our clients, volunteers and employees. During this time, we have expanded our Food Distribution Programs into rural, underserved areas including Ridge Spring and Graniteville and the number of households receiving food from our Food Pantry and Senior Food Programs has doubled since March.

To meet the growing needs of those impacted, we have provided services to individuals and families outside of our Aiken County service areas to include Barnwell, Edgefield and Saluda Counties.
