The Defending Childhood Initiative (**DCI**) is a program of the Division of Violence Prevention at the BPHC. DCI supports systems and communities to better recognize, respond to, and prevent children and youth exposure to violence.

At this interactive training participants will:

- Learn about the healing role of relationships in early childhood education and children's capacity to experience & recover from trauma.
- Increase self-awareness of identity (race, ethnicity, gender, etc.) and the role identities play in working with children, families, and other care networks.
- Identify strategies that support parent & caregiver partnerships.
- Strengthen individual and collective self-care while supporting children & families.
- Connect with other early child care providers and share trauma & resilience resources.


