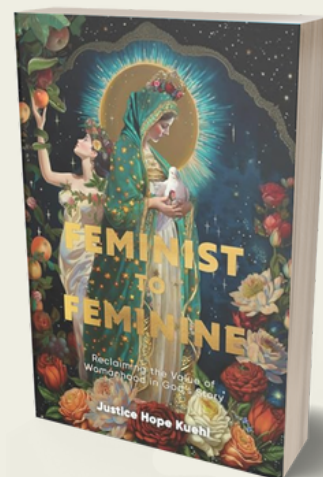

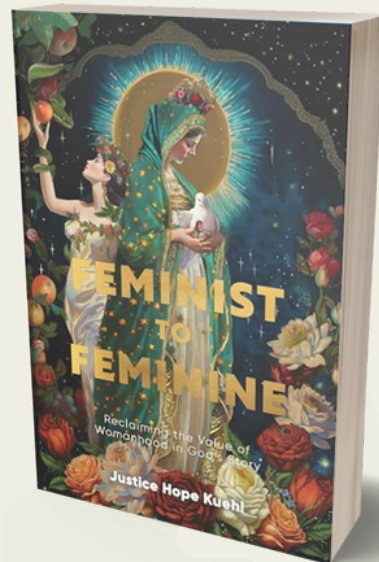
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ABOUT THE BOOK

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SUGGESTED QUESTIONS

- Is the 'Girl Boss' mentality hurting women or nudging them from their true purpose? How so? Can women be both a 'Girl Boss' and what God wants them to be in their homes and for their families? What convinced you?
- Given the historical struggle for women's rights in the workplace, why should women consider stepping back from career pursuits now? How do biblical teachings inform this discussion?
- From your perspective, what biblical examples or teachings are most relevant for navigating challenges faced by single women who seek to balance personal fulfillment with biblical values of femininity? I.e., what about women who aren't married and/or don't have children? Where are they to find fulfillment and purpose?
- Could you share your journey from being Miss Tennessee to becoming a wife and mother? How did your experiences in pageantry shape your approach to family life and ministry? And what about that experience, in retrospect, was helpful and life-giving? What about it was the most hurtful or damaging?
- Do you believe women should work outside of the home, based on your studies? How can women balance career and family aspirations?
- What was the perception of men, masculinity and gender roles, as defined by the Bible, in the world of pageantry and feminists?
- How has this change in your life and direction altered your friendships/relationships with women from your past? How do you navigate those differences?
- Do you feel like there are people/women who see what you've done and look down on you? Who are judgmental?
- What did you believe as a younger woman that it meant for a wife to 'submit' to her husband? How was that viewpoint misinformed? What does it really mean?
- What are your thoughts on pageantry and things like body image? How do those things reconcile with the message of your book?
- How do you perceive the portrayal of modern feminism in current TV shows and movies? Do you see these portrayals as accurate reflections of feminist values, or are they often simplified or distorted for entertainment purposes?
- How can the church better support women in embracing their unique callings and roles in the world/culture ... while also honoring biblical principles of identity and purpose?
