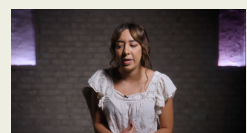

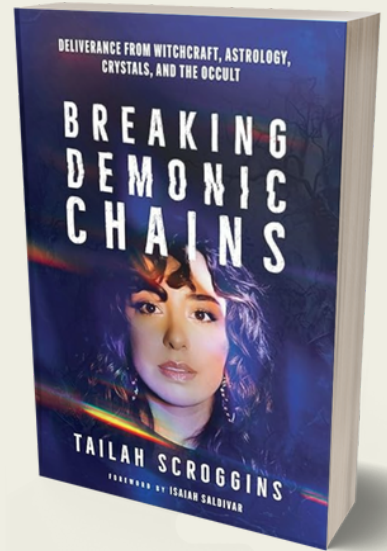

Recounting her own escape from the occult, former New Age witch Tailah Scroggins exposes the lies and secrets of the modern-day occult, revealing the ancient demonic origins and influences behind astrology, tarot cards, psychics, crystals, yoga and more. WHY IS IT RELEVANT?

- Tailah herself got into practices that the culture would call normal today, but that she now thinks the bible would call witchcraft. Her church and home didn't equip her against these practices, but this book offers first hand insights to prepare Christians.
- The Hill reported in 2018 that "a recent [Pew Research Center poll](#) found 62 percent of Americans hold **New Age** beliefs, such as **astrology** and the presence of spiritual energy in trees or mountains.
- Many people, especially Millennials and Gen Z, are struggling with **anxiety, depression, and mental illness**. Turning to half-baked spirituality and crystals, they don't recognize that engaging in the **occult** makes the oppression they are facing even heavier. They are hungry for truth, however many don't understand that there are only two kingdoms: The Kingdom of God and the Kingdom of Darkness. Tailah offers truth, deliverance and healing prayers and lets them know that Jesus is who they are searching for.
- [Pew Research](#) (Feb 2025) shows 70% of Americans feel spiritual but are less religious, with 50% of college students unaffiliated. Tailah's message meets this hunger with Christ-centered solutions.

- How did you come to place your identity and trust in Jesus?
- Why do you believe so many Christians are unknowingly participating in occult practices today?
- What are some signs that someone may need deliverance, even if they're already a believer?
- What would you say to a young woman today who's being drawn to witchcraft because it feels empowering or healing?
- What practical steps can someone take to cut spiritual ties with their past involvement in witchcraft, astrology, or new age beliefs?
- Why spiritually cleanse your home?
- What limits should Christians place on the music, movies and other entertainment we engage with?
- How are the objects used to seek divine guidance in the Bible (urim and thummim, casting lots, etc.) different from occult rituals?



It all started with an astrology book, a gift from my father, who was searching for spiritual truth. He spoke passionately about ancient constellations, and the zodiac sign that I fell under, Aries. I found myself captivated by the idea of my destiny being written in the stars. This caused me at the age of sixteen to dive headfirst into astrology while attending church, singing on the worship team, and leading classmates to the Lord.

I had also found myself drawn to a yoga class offered by my high school when I was in ninth grade, in which I unknowingly stepped into occult practices. Little did I know that each yoga pose was a worship pose to invoke false gods, which the Bible calls demons. Each day, the yoga instructor led us through poses while speaking Hindu chants over us, worshipping these false gods and goddesses. The environment I experienced while practicing yoga was nothing like the presence of the Holy Spirit, whom I knew and loved. Yet there was an allure about the spiritual energy in the room. The atmosphere felt good—even blissful at times, as sin often does. I was instantly hooked. Little did I know that this seemingly harmless activity would allow demonic spirits into my life.

Looking back, yoga felt relaxing in the moment, but as soon as the yoga mat was rolled away, the peace faded, and I was just as cranky, anxious, and rude as I had been before class. I slowly became more angry, bitter, and hot-tempered the more I did yoga. The peace was never transformative or lasting, the way it was after I spent time with God.

As I delved deeper into the world of astrology and yoga, I unknowingly blurred the lines between Christianity and New Age beliefs and practices. I turned to yoga instead of God for peace, and I read horoscopes every day instead of seeking God about His plans for my life. Because these practices were so normalized, I had no idea that I had one foot in the occult and the other in church.

I wasn't trying to replace God with New Age practices; it slowly happened over time because they were convenient and available. I was less motivated to wake up early in the morning and meditate on the Word of God, because I knew I had a yoga class later and would be able to unwind there. It was easier to google my daily horoscope instead of turning off the distractions, praying, and seeking God's voice.

I still believed in God, but He was no longer the first place I turned for guidance; astrology was. This is one of Satan's strategies. He will present distractions and false practices that seem helpful in order to make less room for Jesus in our hearts. Sadly, I didn't know the Bible well enough to understand that participating in astrology and yoga was sinful. Looking back, I wish someone had told me that anything that comes between you and God and competes for your time, affection, and devotion is an idol.

I lived in sin, mixing the occult with Christianity for the rest of my high school years. I was a full-blown astrologer by high school graduation. At that point, my dreams of becoming a worship singer/songwriter were coming true. I was working on my first major project, had a manager, and had made brand-new connections in the music industry. Just as I was about to step into this promising new chapter, the business deal fell through, leaving my dreams shattered. Promises of recording contracts and management deals faded away, and Satan's lies filled my head. These lies told me that God had opened the doors to my dreams, only to cruelly slam them shut in my face. The enemy tried to convince me that God was not a good Father, and that He didn't have plans to prosper me. I took the bait of Satan by believing these lies, and my heart hardened against the Lord.

In Sunday school, I used to find myself wondering how Satan had managed to turn a third of the angels in heaven against God. Now I understand the power of his lies and how he exploits our pain, disappointment, and fears to turn us against God. He often accuses God of being a tyrant so we will turn our backs on Him and serve ourselves instead. Other times, he may convince us of his lie that, If God really loved you, He would have saved you from that tragedy. He would have answered your prayers. Satan knows just how to manipulate and twist our pain to make you and me doubt God. He knows that a heart hardened against God will be joining him in hell for eternity. And that's his goal, beloved—to spite God and drag as many precious souls to hell with him as possible.
