They married in 1986 and have since been blessed with three daughters, two sons-in-law, two granddaughters and three grandsons. Through his pastoral leadership and the work of From His Heart Ministries, Pastor Jeff continues to impact lives both locally and globally, sharing the message of Christ's love and grace.

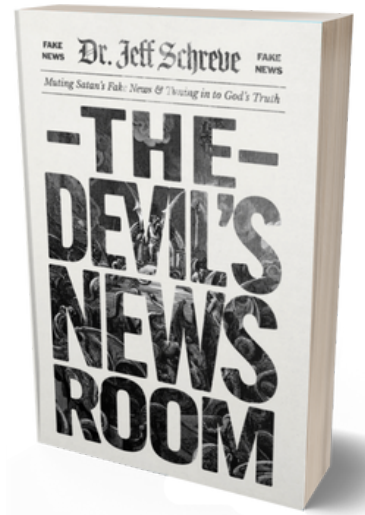
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THE DEVIL'S NEWSROOM

Muting Satan's Fake News & Tuning in to God's Truth



The Devil's Newsroom exposes Satan's origins and deceptive tactics through Scripture. Beginning with Ezekiel's account of Satan as a fallen angel corrupted by pride, it analyzes his three-pronged deception strategy in Genesis: subtle, blatant, and twisted lies. With urgent biblical insight, Jeff Schreve reveals how Satan twists truth to destroy—and how Christ's victory offers complete freedom from these ancient deceptions that still enslave millions today.

WHY IS IT RELEVANT?

- A recent study stated that over 50% of Christians were “actively **deconstructing their faith**.” Concurrently, over 70% of the nation was “wide open” to spiritual things. These two data points, in conjunction with the explosion of faith-based movements in younger generations, point to an appetite for answers.
- Deception in **media**, culture and even within the church, is growing.
- Biblical truths for overcoming sin are crucial as 2025 headlines highlight battles over **pornography and sexual ethics** (e.g., debates on age-restriction laws).
- High-profile **leadership scandals** in the church and elsewhere make lessons from Peter's failure and restoration resonate.
- As **universalism** gains traction—2025 Barna research shows 43% of Christians believe “all religions lead to God”—Jeff's focus on Revelation's “sobering reality of hell” is a wake-up call for people of faith to reject watered-down theology and uphold biblical exclusivity.
- With **mental health** crises spiking, the book's emphasis on “hope found exclusively in Christ's redemptive sacrifice” offers a counter-narrative to despair.
- In an era of **misinformation**—2025 X trends show enormous distrust in mainstream media—Jeff's analysis of Satan's “twisted lies” (like those in Genesis) equips readers to discern truth, especially when cultural narratives clash with biblical values.
- As Western nations drift from faith, Jeff's “urgent biblical insight” into Satan's tactics and Christ's victory inspires people of faith to push for **revival**, aligning with conservative calls for a return to Judeo-Christian roots.

- Speaking of Satan, why would God have created such a being? And if Lucifer was an angel as the Bible says, where would the unrighteousness found in him have come from?
- What is the world's most believed lie?
- Why do people lose hope?
- What was Satan's first lie?
- How can we discern truth from lies as we watch news, listen to professors, go to the movies and follow others on social media and in culture?
- What are the most common ways/tactics the devil uses to sow doubt and confusion?
- Why are so many believers who are dead to sin seemingly addicted to drugs, alcohol, porn and the like?
- What do we learn from Simon Peter's epic failure?
