PARKS AND RECREATION - CAPITAL PROJECT RESIDENT FEEDBACK SURVEY

The Department of Parks and Recreation would like to hear from our community! We are launching a brief survey regarding the Town's upcoming annual Capital Budget request.

As we begin the start of the fiscal 2024 budget process, we would like to hear from residents regarding our capital budget and where they want to see us focus investment. Town departments submit capital budget requests to the First Selectman in the fall as part of the Town's annual budget process. Capital Projects are items that need funding that fall outside of the normal annual operating expenses, like equipment, infrastructure, and major upgrades to facilities. Capital projects also have a useful life of many years. For example, this means equipment that is expected to last in operation for 15 years or infrastructure/land improvements expected to last for 20 years.

Beginning today, Monday August 15, 2022, residents will have the opportunity to share their feedback and ideas with a brief 5 question survey.
