There are no refunds and we do not prorate fees. Requests for a credit will only be considered if received in writing prior to the start of the program. There is a \$20 administrative fee per activity section for credits.

Camp Withdrawal Policy

This policy applies to Adventurers, Kamp Kairphree, and Music and Art camps. There are NO refunds and we do not pro-rate fees. Requests for full credit (100% of fee paid) will be considered prior to June 1. June 1 or after, only half credit (50% of fee paid) will be considered. Once camp begins, the credit will also be pro-rated. There is a \$20 administrative fee per activity section for credits.

Youth Tennis Clinics

Youth Tennis Clinics at the Bruce Park Tennis Courts are great for new players and players who want to enhance their skills. All clinics will be led by experienced instructors and will focus on the fundamentals and rules of tennis in a fun, energetic environment.



The program is for players ages 4 through 15 years old. Clinics are 30 minutes for Lollipops, 45 min for Pee Wee, and 60 minutes for Junior Beginner/Intermediates. They are held in two week sessions, Monday through Thursday, with a rain date of Friday.

Track Clinic

In collaboration with Greenwich Road Runners, the track clinic is a fun and social environment for youth 7 through 13 years old. The clinic takes place at the Greenwich High School Track and is designed to help children learn the basics of running while developing overall fitness and skills. The 5 week session meets 2 evenings per week and is capped off with a final track meet.



FEE: \$50 residents / **\$70** non-residents.

April 15 for non-residents.



Music & Art Camp

Located in Greenwich Public Schools from June 25 - July 26 (No Camp 7/4).

Music Camp is Monday - Friday from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. for children entering grades 4 through 9. Instruction is supplemented with play time for games and other fun activities! There is a Beginner Band option for those that don't have one year of study with an instrument.

Art Camp has morning and afternoon options, Monday - Friday from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. and from 12:30 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.

Afternoon art is only open to those enrolled in morning music.

Summer swim lessons are for residents only. Registration begins April 1.

Summer at the Skatepark



Ramp Camp is a half day camp for children ages 6 - 14 to skate, learn new tricks, and engage in recreational activities while fostering new friendships, and having fun! Camp runs 9 a.m. - 12 p.m., Monday - Thursday; rain date on Fridays.

FEE: \$210 residents/ \$230 non-residents, per week



Pee-Wee Clinics are for children ages 6 - 10 to learn park etiquette and basic techniques such as drop-ins and ollies in a safe and fun atmosphere. Clinics run from 6 p.m. - 7 p.m. Monday - Thursday; rain date on Fridays.

FEE: \$100 residents/ \$120 non-residents, per week

Private instruction is also available.
Registration begins April 1 for residents,
April 15 for non-residents.

Adventurers Camp is a program for children **ages 8-15**.
It runs **Monday—Friday** from **9 a.m. — 4 p.m.**



Organized by age and interest, the program includes theme weeks with onsite activities, one special field trip per week, and local beach days at Greenwich Point and Island Beach. The summer is split into two sessions, totaling 7 weeks. The onsite location is the Bendheim Western Greenwich Civic Center. Transportation is included for all trips and beach days.

Kamp Kairphree

Kamp Kairphree is a program for children **ages 5 - 12**.
It runs **Monday—Friday, 9 a.m. - 4 p.m.**

After being sorted into pre-determined units by age, campers rotate between the on-site location (TBD) and two locations at Greenwich Point Beach. Units of similar ages will travel and play together. Each Wednesday all campers go to Island Beach by ferry to spend the day, weather permitting. Regular daily activities include arts and crafts, sports, canoeing, and board games. Special events as well as on-site entertainment will also be held throughout the summer.

Pre-selected bus stops throughout Greenwich are available for a.m. pick up and p.m. drop off at no extra charge.
