# **Letter from the Director**

Dear Parents:

On behalf of the Department of Parks and Recreation and the teachers, welcome to the Town of Greenwich Preschool Program. The Preschool Program is held at the Cos Cob Community Center, 54 Bible Street, Cos Cob.

The Cos Cob Community Preschool is very unique and exciting. We use a play based curriculum and believe that play leads the way to discovery and learning. Children are provided with opportunities to learn through many different variations of play. Parents are an integral part of our program. We believe that parents are their child's first and most important teachers. Their input and information about their child is continually sought and valued.

The Preschool is licensed by the State of Connecticut. In order for us to comply with regulations, all parents must completely fill out an Enrollment Form, Daycare Authorization Form, and obtain a copy of the child's health record and immunization schedule from their doctor. All children must be fully toilet trained when they begin the program.

When registering, you will be required to pay a \$100 non-refundable deposit for each day of the week your child will be attending the Preschool.

The deposit is deducted from your first session payment. All required paperwork must be completed and submitted to the Department of Parks & Recreation, along with the balance of your first session payment by early August.

This preschool program, licensed by the State of Connecticut, is for children who are 3 years-old by September 1, 2024, 4 year-olds, and children turning 5 after September 1, 2024. Our Head Teacher is certified by the State of CT, and the Town of Greenwich employs three teachers for the program.

Classes are held Monday-Friday, 9 a.m.— 12 p.m. and families may sign up for classes 3 to 5 days per week. *Classes are limited to 26 children.* 

The Cos Cob Community Preschool program runs on the public school schedule with some exceptions. All children must be <u>completely toilettrained</u> when the program begins.
