

ATHLETIC FIELDS UPDATE

LOCATED AT TOWN OF GREENWICH PARKS AND GREENWICH PUBLIC SCHOOLS

EFFECTIVE JULY 6, 2020 DAILY, WEATHER PERMITTING

THE FIRST SELECTMAN, IN COLLABORATION WITH HIS EMERGENCY TASK FORCE, ANNOUNCES THE MANAGED **RE-OPENING** OF TOWN ATHLETIC FIELDS.

ACCESS TO TOWN ATHLETIC FIELDS ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING RULES:

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES CAREFULLY. THEY ARE INTENDED TO ENSURE YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY, AND THAT OF FELLOW PLAYERS. ANYONE CAUGHT IN VIOLATION WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A LOSS OF FIELD PRIVILEGES FOR THE SEASON.

- 1. Town of Greenwich athletic fields at parks and public schools are available for use by permit from the Department of Parks and Recreation.
- 2. Field permits are available to residents and Town organizations for various activities including, but not limited to, sports organizations practicing and games, exercise classes, personal training, family parties, company softball games.
- 3. In addition to normal requirements to obtain a field permit, each person or organization must complete and sign an "Agreement in Response to COVID-19". Organizations must also submit a "COVID-19 Operation Plan".
- 4. Request for a field permit must be made at least two weeks in advance of the required date. Please contact recreation@greenwichct.org
- 5. Social distancing of at least 6 feet must be maintained at all times when on the property including in the parking lot. You must immediately leave the property after your visit and not congregate in the parking lot.
- 6. Everyone must have a cloth face covering or higher level of protection whenever close contact is unavoidable while using the park/school facilities.
- 7. In addition to the above, all other regular athletic field rules for grass and synthetic turf fields apply.
- 8. Town of Greenwich Field Monitors will be at the fields to ensure rule compliance by all players.

Although we will continue to make every effort to provide a healthy environment, PLEASE MAKE RESPONSIBLE DECISIONS, BASED ON YOUR PERSONAL RISK PROFILE, ON WHETHER TO EXPOSE YOURSELF TO OTHERS.

We will continue to provide access to our customers during this heightened alert period as long as everyone obeys the above safety practices. We will continue to monitor the recommendations by the CDC, local, state and national authorities and keep you updated on changes. IF YOU, A FAMILY MEMBER OR SOMEONE YOU HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH HAS RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS, PARTICULARLY A FEVER, DO NOT VISIT THE PARK/SCHOOL FACILITIES.
