Puppet Workshop

Immediately following the show, The Puppeteer
Matthew Leonard will have a **Puppet Workshop***.

The Lionheart Puppet Company currently offers a
delightful shadow puppet workshop for children
ages 6-10. Shadow puppetry is believed to be the
earliest form of puppetry and allows children the
opportunity to explore the uses of light and
shadow.

Utilizing a series of pre-designed puppet patterns,
the children will learn the basics of puppet jointing
and construction ultimately creating their own
animal shadow puppet.

Following this, the children will then learn the
elements of puppet performance as they are led
through a series of exercises moving the puppets
across a shadow screen. Students will even learn
how to build a simple shadow screen of their own
using common items found around the home.

To participate in the Puppet Workshop, children must be in 2nd grade or older
