## **DIRECTIONS** **FROM I-95 NORTH OR SOUTH**

Take I-95 to Exit 5 to us1 (post road) in Old Greenwich, CT. Turn right at US-1. Go one block to Sound Beach Avenue and turn right. Go approx. 1/8th mile to Forest Avenue and turn left (at the stone church). Continue to Harding Road, and turn left at the stop sign. The Civic Center will be on your right and parking is on the left.
