








COVID-19 Cases by Borough

Key Points:

- In the week 19 to 25 Feb, the 7-day case rate all ages was 65.4 per 100,000. The rate for England was 97.1 per 100,000.
- The 7-day case rate (all ages) varied between local authorities: 38.9 (Lewisham) to 122.6 (Ealing) per 100,000.
- As of 1 March, 2,083,490 Londoners have received their first vaccination dose, with 82,377 having received their second dose.
- Bus journeys increased by +3% (+404,035 journeys) and tube journeys increased by +5% (+215,149 journeys) in the week ending 21 Feb compared to the previous.
