ABOUT THE BRENTFORD PROJECT

When complete, The Brentford Project will deliver around 800 new homes alongside 14,000 sq m of retail and 4,000 sq m of commercial space, in addition to new public realm – including an extended Thames path.

The project will also incorporate 11 buildings and reinstate Brentford's historic connections to the water via a series of distinctive pedestrianised lanes and yards, paying homage to the area's integral role in London's industrial past.

WHAT HAS HAPPENED ON SITE IN AUGUST?

August was another busy month on site, with the basement sheet piling works starting on plots B, C and K. The sheet piles will form the wall of the new basements and range in size from 7m to 9m in length – they are being pressed into the below ground clay and the process used doesn't cause any vibration or excessive noise. Foundation piling works have also commenced on plot K – with a total of 109 piles to be installed.

Completions on site include the final electrical diversions and disconnections by Scottish and Southern Electric (SSE), and the decommission of the Brent Way substation. The sewer diversion works on Brentford High Street also completed this month – with the 300mm Thames Water sewer which originally ran through the site being diverted around the new buildings.

And finally, the substructure works to plot K have commenced – meaning the groundworks contractor can now begin to install foundation pile caps, ground beams and the drainage and utility infrastructure on site.



WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

In September we will bring the sheet piling works to a close on plots B, C and K – with foundation piling works also completing on plot K – which means the start of plot B and C foundation works can commence.

The erection of the site's first tower crane will begin next month as substructure works continue to plot K, whilst the sheet capping beam construction will commence on plots B and C along with the basement bulk excavation works.

Further progress will be made with the installation of the electrical cables required to power the development's new substation – which will take place from Boston Manor, continue down Half Acre and then into situ on site.

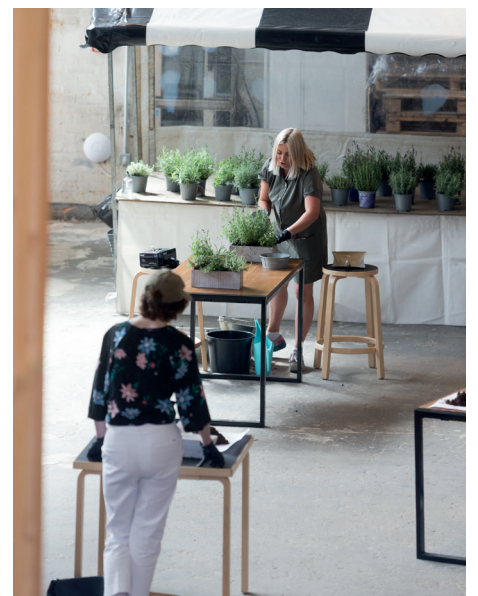
SANTA MARIA PIZZA WELCOMES CUSTOMERS TO DINE-IN
