Getting the country building again

You will soon see us getting back to work at High Street Quarter, Hounslow, from Monday 1st June 2020, where we are building high quality homes and a great place to live.

We want to build the homes our country needs, but our priority is to keep everyone safe and to do the right thing for our employees, partners and the general public. As a responsible business, we were one of the first UK construction companies to take decisive action and temporarily close our sites in March. While we were not required to close, we wanted to take the time to develop a set of new and enhanced working practices so that our sites and sales offices can operate as safely as possible during the coronavirus pandemic.

Our new guidelines are in line with, or exceed, the advice from government, industry and public health authorities. As well as new ways of working and physical changes to our site, a new Social Distancing Marshal will also ensure the new guidelines are followed.

Giving the NHS the tools it needs to do more

We are all in this together and we want to play our part in supporting our frontline NHS. Over recent weeks, we have contributed around £125,000 to NHS charities and initiatives across the country, donated more than 5,000 of our medical-grade facemasks to the NHS and we have given around 400 of our defibrillators to the St John Ambulance in England and Wales as well as St Andrew's First Aid in Scotland. We've also donated a £50,000 to The Sun's Who Cares Wins appeal, providing help for NHS frontline staff during the Covid-19 pandemic.
