Welcome from Sally and Alan

We are so pleased after the past 18 months or so, to be able to meet in person. Remote meetings do have their place but face to face meetings in a convivial atmosphere cannot be beaten!

Last year Sally had to be convinced that we could hold our Awards ceremony via Zoom, but we did, and they went remarkably well. But it does seem odd to be dressed smartly from top to toe – last year we just had to concentrate on the top half.

In the early part of the year we continued with our regular webinars, and we held a number of joint networking remote events with various other London Chambers.

As soon as restrictions were officially lifted, we were the first London Chamber to hold a major flagship event, the Regeneration & Recovery event on 23rd July. The majority of the major developers were represented.

The day went well, with presentations running concurrently, concentrating on regeneration and regrowth. The evening ended with a drink's reception. A couple of our speakers were pinged before the event, but we linked with them via Zoom and all went relatively smoothly.

Since July, we have been introducing our business breakfasts, with one a month, crisscrossing the boroughs. More will be coming!

In November, we held a successful live international trade event, concentrating on trading with the UAE, with a guest speaker from Dubai and nearly 50 attendees coming from as far away as Kent.

We also continue to work closely with Hounslow, Ealing and Hammersmith & Fulham Councils, who we welcome here tonight, where we operate as West London Local Chambers to deliver class leading Chambers services to all three boroughs.

Alongside all this, we are a Kickstart Gateway helping the hardest to reach young people into 6- month work placements. To date we have placed 170 young people with a variety of employers from Hounslow to Camberwell. Some have now reached the end of their placements and have been offered full time employment, It is gratifying to see all our hard work paying off.

Now to the Business Awards 2020/2021, we have received a record number of entries. Like last year the awards were open to any business within the three boroughs and any business who are members of the Chambers. We do want to congratulate all those who have been shortlisted, as this year has thrown up many challenges for many of us, but as always we show tenacity.

Lastly, we do want to thank all our sponsors, and all of you in the room. Without you, we would not be the Chamber we are today. Tonight, is a night to celebrate our successes!

Message from Cllr Guy Vincent

The London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham is proud to sponsor the Hounslow Chamber and West London Local Chambers Business Awards and to support businesses in H&F and across West London.

We believe local government has a role in supporting growth. It can bring partners together, regenerate town centres, help with affordable workspaces, teach people the skills they need, use procurement to support local firms and much more. In H&F, we want to use the power of local government to create a borough able to compete with the best in the 21st century. Hammersmith & Fulham is already home to a thriving business community, including global companies such as GE, Disney, and L'Oréal. However, the borough also has one of the highest concentration of start-up firms. On top of this, there is a thriving media and arts scene such as the BBC and Endemol, as well as the renowned Bush and Lyric theatres, the Apollo and LAMDA.

Our innovative Industrial Strategy is focusing on accelerating growth in key sectors where there are already pockets of innovation.

However, certain characteristics of the local economy have made it vulnerable to certain Covid related detriments: around one in five jobs in the borough are within the retail/wholesale sector; 90% of businesses in the borough are micro-businesses; the number of businesses involved in the night-time economy in the borough is above the West London average; 8.7% of 50+ residents in the borough are on work-related benefits, higher than the London average. These characteristics have informed our many business support activities. For instance, the popular Our Space is Your Space initiative was introduced and more than 150 businesses have now benefitted from new or increased outdoor trading space. The start-up senior school invited recently unemployed residents over the age of 50 to gain valuable insights into the process of starting a business, using peer support and facilitated discussions to build confidence.

In H&F we are investing in an online e-commerce and local delivery platform that will create a “virtual high street” allowing residents to keep spend in the local economy. All deliveries will be carried out by green transport, supporting the council’s wider climate change ambitions.

The Business Network is a borough wide stakeholder engagement group consisting of representatives from the borough’s Business Improvement Districts, business associations, shopping centres, higher education, FSB, The Chamber and other interested business representatives and professionals. Proposed business recovery projects are now discussed and reviewed by the group as part of the council’s decision-making process.

We know that a community will only thrive if its businesses are thriving and growing. H&F starts from a strong base of established businesses and as a council we are committed to work with our businesses to help them recover from the shock of Covid and to build for the future.

My congratulations to all the businesses that have been nominated for Business Awards. They demonstrate the innovation, depth and variety of the business community in West London.
