FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends,

Worship is a part of our DNA. The early church saint, Augustine, (who lived 354 to 430 and was bishop of North Africa) said that “a Christian should be an Alleluia from head to foot.” My week is missing something critical if I am not in worship. I feel like I am not connecting to God, my faith is not being challenged and supported, and the voice of my joyful praise of God is diminished. I go to worship (besides it being my job – ha, ha) because it completes my week and lifts me into the next. If I am going to be an alleluia from head to foot, then worship needs to be a part of me.

Worship is also about God. We gather to praise God, to sing to God, to listen for God, to pray to God, to hear and reflect on God's Word, and when I receive communion, I experience the grace and presence of God. I need each one of you to be a part of the worship experience, too. It connects us to God and to each other. Worship binds us together in ways that encourage and support us. Worship grounds us in life: ours, each other's, and God's. Worship is our expression and experience of joy. Worship helps us to become an “Alleluia.”

King David is an example of worshipping with his entire being. In 2 Samuel 6, David moves the Ark of the Covenant into Jerusalem. The Ark was created during Moses and Aaron's time, and it traveled with the Israelites as they wandered for forty years in the wilderness. In the period of the Judges, it was captured by the Philistines and then returned to the Israelites and kept at the house of Abinadab. David has it moved to Jerusalem to a tent of worship that he has erected. As the Ark is moved, there is a great worship celebration which includes dancing by David, singing, playing of instruments, sacrifices, offerings, and banquets.

At Forrest Burdette, we are blessed to have great worship. Our music is a beautiful blend of the best of traditional hymns, choral pieces, and contemporary praise choruses. The attractiveness of the sanctuary lends to the joy of worship. The sincerity of the prayers and centrality of the Word adds to the worship celebration. The waters of baptism and the gift of communion are high moments in the sanctuary. The laughter, smiles, and fellowship let us know that we are at home in God's house. In October, our worship will continue with the theme “Living Like a King” and using my study book based on David.

Our worship helps us be an “Alleluia!” from head to foot. I look forward to being an “Alleluia!” with you on Sunday!
