Soft Launch of the FBLAUNCH Tutoring Center/ Coffee Shop: Sunday, July 9

We received a \$9,000 grant from the United Methodist Foundation to incorporate a tutoring center/coffee shop into Forrest Burdette MUMC. David and the youth are hard at work transforming the Little Narthex into the location for the FBLaunch Tutoring Center/Coffee Shop. We will have a soft launch for it, where students will help prepare coffees on the morning of Sunday, July 9, before our worship service begins at 10:30 AM. Students will begin serving coffee/tea/juice/cereal beginning at 9:15 AM during Sunday School. The coffee will be served for free with donations encouraged. This will be a donations-based coffee bar, so if you have some change to spare, then that's perfect! The youth will continue to meet for Sunday School in the FBLaunch Coffee Shop for the rest of July. Then, in August, we will do an official grand-opening! Stay tuned for more information.

Catching a Glimpse of God's Vision for Forrest Burdette

God has been working with our congregation for 108 years and has been guiding our vision process for the past 16 months. The Vision Team and the Church Council believe that God is calling us to seek God's direction for FBMUMC for the 2020s and 2030s. We know that COVID has challenged and changed the way we experience life, and it has altered the church's traditional patterns of life. In addition, the previous assumptions we have made about church being the center of people's lives are no longer applicable.

The Vision Team believes that we have seen what God is envisioning for us as a church. This summer we will share in weekly worship, after church sermon discussions, and communicated in a variety of ways the new mission statement and the themes of ministry that God is calling us to live out. We are excited to share our discernment with the church and seek your reflections and comments, as well as confirmation of the vision.

During the summer, we will share our new mission statement and focus on *Establishing New Connections in the Community* (7/9), *Generating Connections within the Church* (7/16), *Deepening Individual Connections with Christ* (7/23), *Connecting Faith to Everyday Life* (7/30), and *New Life for Forrest Burdette* (8/6). Each Sunday we will receive the detailed proposal for the weekly theme. We kicked off looking at our Vision on June 25 with our new mission statement, "Sharing Christ's Love with Our Community," and reminding us of the biblical call to "love one another, because love is from God; everyone who loves is born of God and knows God." (1 John 4:7).

On the first of September, everyone will receive a completed copy of the proposed Vision for Forrest Burdette. On Sunday, September 17, all will have an opportunity to affirm and adopt the Vision. God is leading the church to embrace the future with faith!
