- ProCare Registration



1st Day of School Don't forget to bring...

Water bottle (filled with water)

Lunch box

Snack (in a labeled Ziploc bag)

Backpack large enough to accommodate your child's schoolwork, lunch box AND water bottle (no mini backpacks)

1-2 changes of clothes (shirt, pants, underwear and socks) in a labeled Ziploc bag

All school supplies that are not included in your supply box (you can also bring these to your Meet the Teacher appointment)

Please remember, we are a completely nut-free school. If you pack a sandwich that has something resembling peanut butter (but is nut-free), please make sure to label the sandwich bag NUT-FREE so we know it's safe. Thanks!
