Clear Your Cache

Typically the data stored in your computer's cache are used to reload websites much faster, but when a cache stores old files - like the old Registry website - it can create errors. Since the website has been updated, clearing your cache will help your computer run faster and prevent error notices.

Instructions for Clearing your Cache

Important note: when clearing your cache, you must clear your cache for all time and not just the past few days or weeks.

Google Chrome (<https://support.google.com/accounts/answer/32050?co=GENIE.Platform%3DDesktop&hl=en&oco=0>)

1. On your computer, open **Chrome**.
2. At the top right, click “More” .
3. Click **More tools**, then click **Clear browsing data...**
4. At the top, choose a time range **All time**, to delete everything.
5. Next to “**Cookies and other site data**” and “**Cached images and files**,” check the boxes
6. Click **Clear data**.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Click the **Menu** button and select **Options**.
2. Select the **Privacy & Security** panel.
3. In the “Cookies and Site Data” section, click **Clear Data**.
4. Remove the check mark in front of “Cookies and Site Data”.

5. With “Cached Web Content” check marked, click the **Clear** button.
6. Close the “about:preferences” page. Any changes you've made will automatically be saved.
