\$5.8 billion

Child Care Development Block Grant (CCDBG) received an investment of \$5 billion, of which \$236 million was allocated to California to support child care programs in 2018-19.

STATE INVESTMENT

On Wednesday, June 27, Governor Brown signed his final State budget totaling \$201 billion, of which \$4.7 billion is allocated to child care and development programs. CCALA is a partner of the ECE Budget Coalition and together, obtained increased investments related to the Billion for Babies budget ask, including:
