DOORS: ENTRY, SLIDING GLASS, AND SECURITY

General

- An Architectural Modification Application and approval is required before any work is started.
- A Maricopa County Permit is required if the installation involves a structural change to a wall. Refer to 3.2.5.

Locations

- **Entry and Security Doors**
 - Doors leading into a house, garage, golf cart garage, enclosed patio, courtyard, guest house/casita, and storage shed.
 - Roll-down security doors or security shutters NOT allowed on front elevation of house or guest house/casita or in the blind-side wall.
 - Entry and Security doors NOT allowed in blind-side wall.
- **Sliding Glass Doors**
 - Doors leading into house and guest house/casita.
 - Sliding glass doors NOT allowed on front elevation of house or guest house/casita or in blind-side wall.

Design Criteria

- **Entry Doors**
 - Painted Entry Doors – Must be painted the color of the house, trim or an HOA approved door color.
 - Custom Entry Doors – Color should complement the color of the house or trim.
 - Natural Wood-Stained Entry Doors – Are allowed.
- **SLIDING GLASS DOORS – NO DESIGN CRITERIA.**
- **Security Doors**
 - Traditional swing security doors allowed on all entry doors and should complement the structure design.
 - Color should complement the color of the house or trim.
