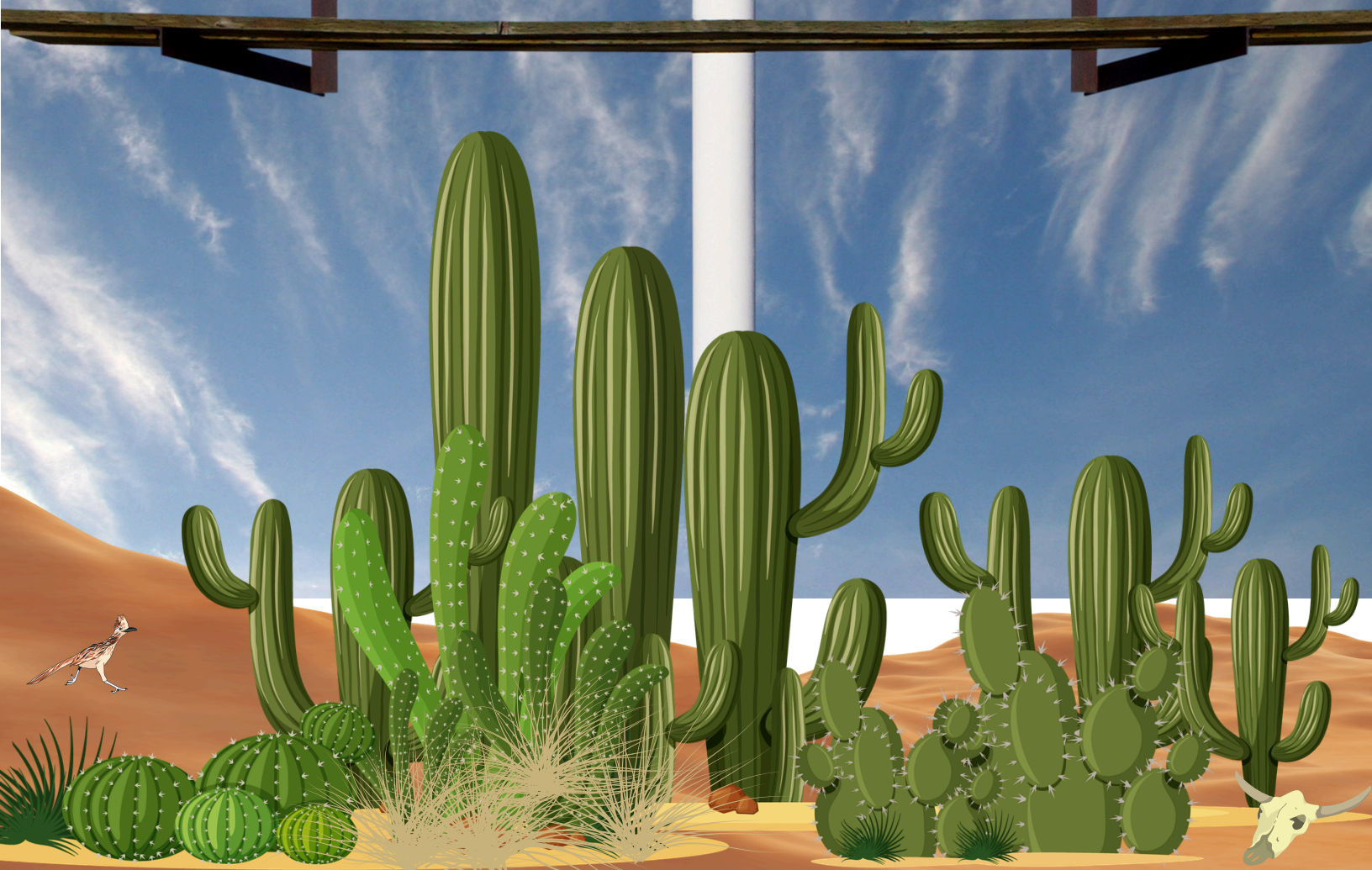

Driving Range Policy

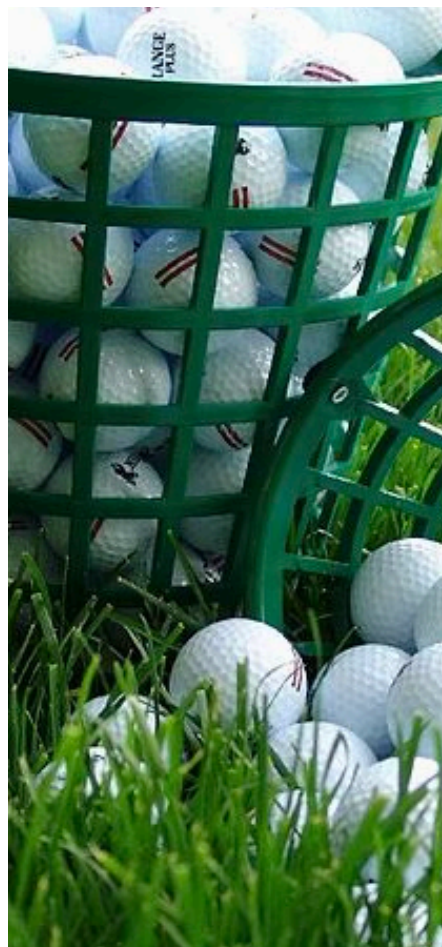
The Cottonwood Driving Range is available to use by all Sun Lakes homeowners and guests.

The range closes early on Monday afternoon at 3 pm for maintenance, otherwise it is open 7 days a week, from dawn until dusk.

All range patrons must adhere to the dress code.

Baskets and golf balls should NOT leave the range area under any circumstances.

The Green Standard: Golf's \$6 Billion Impact on Arizona

As residents of a vibrant golf community, we often see the game as a source of recreation and social connection. However, a recent comprehensive study by the **Rounds Consulting Group and the Arizona Alliance for Golf** reveals that our favorite pastime is also a powerhouse for the state's economy and environmental health.

Here is a look at how the golf industry shapes Arizona's prosperity while maintaining a surprisingly small environmental footprint.

Economic Powerhouse: More Than Just a Game

In 2021, the **golf industry generated a staggering \$6 billion in economic activity** across the state. This impact goes far beyond the pro shop:

Jobs & Wages: The industry supports nearly 66,200 jobs and provided \$2.3 billion in wages to Arizona workers.

Tax Revenue: Golf generated \$518 million in state and local tax revenues, helping fund essential public services.

Property Value Premium: Being part of a golf community pays off. Homes adjacent to golf courses in Arizona see a significant price premium—ranging from 18% to 40% higher than non-adjacent homes—adding billions to total residential real estate value.

Sustainability: The 2% Factor

While water conservation is a top priority for all Arizonans, the data shows that **golf is an incredibly efficient user** of this precious resource.

Low Water Footprint: Golf course irrigation accounts for only 2% of daily statewide water use. To put that in perspective, crop irrigation uses 73.5% and public supply uses 20.7%.

Leading in Innovation: Our industry is at the forefront of using reclaimed wastewater. By filtering and recycling non-potable water for irrigation, courses preserve our drinking water supply while maintaining the green spaces we love.

Environmental Benefits: Cooling the "Heat Island"

Golf courses serve as vital "green lungs" for our urban areas. As temperatures rise, the abundant tree canopies and turfgrass on courses help mitigate the **Heat Island Effect**.

Utility Savings: In cities like Scottsdale, the cooling effect of golf courses saves residents an estimated \$30 million annually in utility costs.

Natural Infrastructure: Existing courses save taxpayers roughly \$500 million in installation and maintenance costs that would otherwise be required for public tree canopy programs.

Community & Charity

The impact of golf is also measured in the lives it touches.

Philanthropy: The industry drives hundreds of millions of dollars toward local non-profits, including the Special Olympics and Hospice of the Valley. The WM Phoenix Open alone has raised over \$110 million for Arizona charities since 2012.

Youth Development: Programs like The First Tee and Youth on Course use golf to teach life skills and empower the next generation of Arizonans.

THE TAKEAWAY: Arizona's golf industry is a "healthy market"—it ranks 30th nationwide for golf accessibility, meaning our growth is stable and well-planned. Whether it's through the \$2.24 billion in added property value or the thousands of local small businesses the industry supports, golf remains a critical pillar of the Arizona lifestyle.

Next time you're on the fairways, know that you're part of an industry that keeps Arizona green, growing, and economically sound.

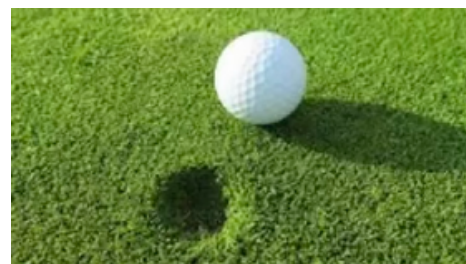
Course & Community: A Friendly Reminder for ALL Golfers

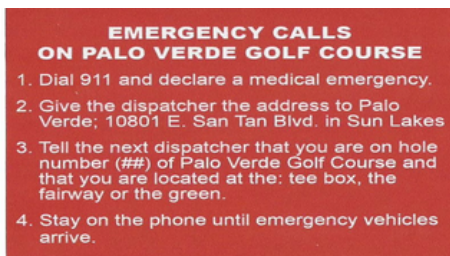


Correct Rake Position

Stop by each Pro Shop to pick up your **Emergency Protocol Sticker**



- Please abide by the **90 degree cart rule** at all times (when not cart path only)
- Please keep up with the group in front of you - **No gaps**
- Head to the cart path before you pass the yellow stakes on all Par 4 and Par 5 holes - **Keep the green surrounds playable**
- **Play ready golf** at all times
- **Fix your ball marks** on the greens
- **Fill your divots** throughout the golf course

Get a Grip: Why Fresh Grips Matter for Your Game

In the world of golf, your hands are your only connection to the club. Over time, heat, dirt, and oils from your skin cause grips to oxidize and harden, leading to a loss of traction and performance. If your clubs are feeling slick or showing visible wear, it's time for a refresh.

The Benefits of Re-Gripping:

Improved Control: Fresh, tacky grips allow you to hold the club with less tension. This promotes a smoother swing tempo and prevents the club from twisting at impact.

Increased Distance: When you aren't worried about the club slipping, you can achieve better

clubhead speed and more consistent ball striking.

Reduced Hand Fatigue: New grips provide better shock absorption, which is easier on your joints—especially during those long practice sessions on the range.

Weather Readiness: High-quality modern grips are designed to maintain traction even in the humid Arizona heat, ensuring your "big stick" stays secure in your hands.

What is proper attire/dress for playing golf at CWPV

Proper dress applies to those playing and/or using any of the practice facilities including the driving range, chipping greens, and putting greens.

Men

- Men may wear pants, or golf shorts no shorter than mid-thigh
- Men MUST have a collared shirt with sleeves
- Mock turtlenecks or turtlenecks are permitted
- Absolutely NO collarless shirts, tank tops, tennis attire, swim wear, or athletic shorts are allowed
- Denim pants, shorts, and shirts (regardless of color) that are uniform in color, do not have holes or tears and are not frayed or raveled are permissible

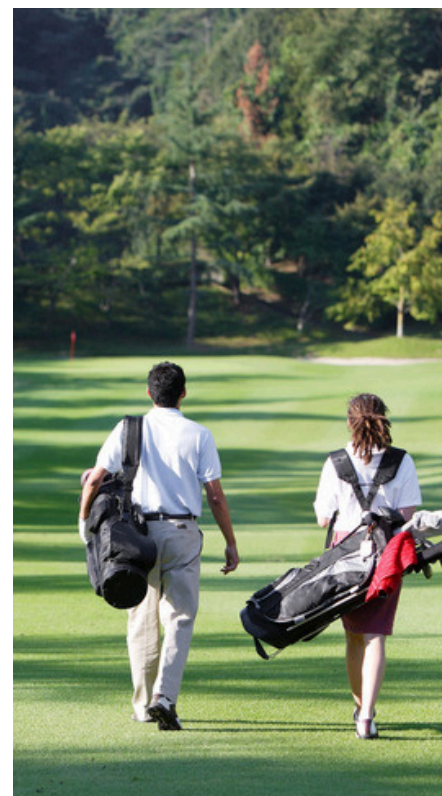
Women

- Women may wear slacks, or shorts/skorts/skirts no shorter than mid-thigh. Collarless and/or sleeveless shirts, blouses, sweatshirts, and sweaters are allowed

- Athletic shorts, swim wear, cut-offs, midriff-exposing tops, halter tops, revealing tank tops, and tennis attire are NOT considered proper dress for golf
- Denim pants, shorts, and shirts (regardless of color) that are uniform in color, do NOT have holes, or tears, and are not frayed or raveled are permissible

All

- All participants MUST wear shoes
- Cottonwood and Palo Verde golf courses are soft spike ONLY facilities. Metal golf spikes are NOT permitted
- Golf shoes, golf sandals, sneakers or rubber-soled shoes MUST be worn on the courses and practice areas
- Any footwear that would damage the greens is strictly prohibited



From Tweeds to Tech: The Evolution of Golf Style

Before the era of moisture-wicking fabrics, golf attire was as much about surviving the elements as it was about etiquette. The history of the "links look" is a fascinating journey from heavy wools to high-performance fashion.

The Era of the Gentleman

In the early days on the rugged coasts of Scotland, golfers dressed for the weather. This meant heavy tweed jackets, starched shirts, and even neckties. Looking like a gentleman was considered just as important as the quality of your ball striking.

The Rise of Plus-Fours

By the 1920s, golf fashion found its first iconic look: knickerbockers, or "plus-fours." These trousers were gathered below the knee to allow for better movement during the swing. Often paired with Argyle socks and flat caps, this silhouette defined the Golden Age of the sport.

The Mid-Century Shift

As golf grew in warmer climates, heavy layers disappeared. The 1950s introduced the knit polo shirt and lightweight slacks. Legends like Arnold Palmer brought a more relaxed aesthetic to the course, trading stiff formality for breathable cottons and vibrant colors.

Tradition Meets Technology

Today's golf attire is the peak of "functional fashion." While the collared shirt remains the standard of etiquette, modern fabrics feature four-way stretch and UV protection designed to withstand the Arizona sun.
