Biking and Walking Safety

We don't have sidewalks, so a few precautions for walkers and bikers are important, especially this time of year when more walkers are out and visitors are in town.

- **Walk facing traffic.** Do all that you can to be seen by drivers. Wear light colored clothing and something reflective. In the dark, carry and wave a flashlight as you walk. Try to make eye contact with oncoming drivers. If walking your dog, keep your pet on a short leash, wearing a reflective collar or leash. Most importantly, walk facing traffic, close to the curb, NOT in the automobile traffic lane.
- **Bike with traffic.** At night, be sure your bike has a light and reflectors, especially on the back. Wear light colored clothing. Be extra aware of traffic approaching you from behind. Install a mirror. Bike close to the curb, NOT in the automobile traffic lane.

Be sure to have identification with you and carry your cell phone. **DRIVERS**, please be extra alert during the dark hours and drive SLOWLY.

Comment Card Corner

The following item has been selected by the Communications Committee and Administrative Services Manager from *white comment cards* submitted by homeowners over the past 12 months.

Homeowner Comment: Great job refurbishing the Bocce Court and surrounding turf at Sisk Park. When will the putting course be revitalized? It is in sorry condition and at times a safety tripping issue. The turf has grass and weeds growing thru in spots. I use it weekly at Lady Putters. Get representatives from Lady Putters and others who use the course and schedule renovation ASAP.

Management Response: The President of Lady Putters was told to reach out to the Facilities & Grounds Committee.

Homeowner Comment: We need dress code at pool. Too many young girls with 'string' up butt and small petal in front - too many comments! Not good. Dress code for club, dress code pool.

Management Response: Spoke with Homeowner and explained the dress code policy for the pools. Suggested they bring a proposal to the Recreation Committee about changes.

Be A Responsible Driver

The maximum legal speed limit on a residential street is 25 mph (unless posted otherwise). Drive 25 mph or less and give yourself more time to react to the unexpected, you may be driving faster than you should. Don't be a speeder, be a leader. Be alert and don't take chances, even on short trips.

Golf Carts are classified as motor vehicles and Arizona law allows the carts to legally drive on the side of auto traffic. Driving in the automobile traffic lane at less than the normal speed of traffic can cause traffic backups and frustrate motorists. Please move over as close as practical to the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway to allow vehicles proceeding in the same direction, to pass to the left of your golf cart at a safe distance.

Prioritize safety over speed for a secure and responsible driving experience. Safely share the streets throughout our communities with other motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists.
