Mediation Skills Training Institute for Church Leaders (MSTI)

Date: August 1-5, 2022

Time: 9:00am to 5:00pm daily

Place: St. Mark's Episcopal Church in Glen Ellyn, IL

Purpose: This workshop is designed for pastors and other church leaders who want to learn how to deal more effectively with interpersonal, congregational, and other forms of group conflict. Participants will acquire knowledge and skills that will help them guide their congregations towards greater unity of spirit and purpose. More specifically, this workshop will help participants to...

- View conflict not merely as something negative but as a positive opportunity for healing and growth
- Place mediation skills within the context of family systems theory
- Practice conflict transformation skills in a variety of settings, including church, home, school, or office
- Help their congregations model the unity and singleness of purpose that should characterize the body of Christ

Facilitator: As Executive Director of the Lombard Mennonite Peace Center, Rev. Jay Wittmeyer brings to the institute many years of practical experience of mediating conflict in churches and organizations, while also training others to be self-differentiated leaders in the midst of congregational anxieties. Since 1983, LMPC has been leading the way in helping the church see conflict as an arena for God's revelation, while fulfilling the mission of helping Christ's church grow in health and wholeness.
