# PSAT/SAT®

On Tuesday, April 9th we will be hosting the SAT School Day at CVCS.

All of our juniors will be participating in this statewide event.

In addition, we will be holding our Spring PSAT testing on this day for grades 8–10. 7th graders will complete their Spring testing as well.

Admissions to the testing site will begin at 7:30am. Designated testing rooms will be posted in the main hallway. All students, including 7th graders, need to be dropped off in time to be in their testing location by 7:55am.

Testing will begin promptly at 8:00am per College Board guidelines. Late arrivers will need to be picked up as they will not be allowed to enter the testing rooms. We appreciate your help with this tricky piece.

If your student is taking the PSAT or the SAT, they MUST bring 2 non-mechanical pencils and an approved calculator from the approved calculator list.

Additionally, they may have a water bottle and snack. All juniors and seniors must show a valid ID to participate that day. Student ID is satisfactory.

All students will be dismissed at 12:00 that day.
