EACH CLASS: Cookies (basic chocolate chip, **NO NUTS!**); apple cider (see amounts below)

- EC: **Cornstalks and path entryway** (provide and set up cornstalks; create and decorate path entryway. 3 dozen cookies; 2 gallons cider. Grade 1-2: **Snacks** for characters (popcorn, fruit, small piece of candy or chocolate, water). You may solicit helpers from other classes. Scarecrows (make a total of 6-8) 3 dozen cookies; 2 gallons cider. Grade 3: Flyer distribution (Camden, Rockport, Rockland, Belfast) 3 dozen cookies; 2 gallons cider. Grade 4: **Trail grooming** (clear brush and debris, paint stony obstacles) 2 dozen cookies; 1 gallon cider Grade 5: **Cookies and cider service** (check storage room for cups: purchase or obtain as needed; receive donations, set up cider table and serve, hand out cookies
- Grade 6: Tree faces (use natural objects to make faces on trees along the trail) 4 dozen gluten-free chocolate chip cookies (NO NUTS!); 2 gallons cider.

Grade 7-8: Lanterns, torches (prepare and set out lanterns along woods path, put torches and lanterns along path parallel to parking lot);
AND Hay bales and campfire (place hay bales as seats around fire and to block wrong turns on trail, build and tend fire: this also includes providing wood for the fire and staying to put the fire out.) 3 dozen cookies; 2 gallons cider.
