PURPOSE:

Primary Care providers do not have knowledge to identify and treat complex behavioral health concerns in pediatric, adolescent, and perinatal patients in the primary care setting. This RSS will offer psychiatry support and education to pediatric and perinatal primary care providers to enhance knowledge and understand available psychiatry referral options. Participants need to learn how to screen, identify, triage, and provide evidence-based treatment for behavioral health concerns in the primary care setting.

This one-hour training (45 minute didactic presentation followed by 15 minutes of Q&A) is designed to fit during the lunch hour, where providers can listen and learn, followed by an opportunity to ask questions.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

- Recognize and diagnose mental and behavioral health symptoms and disorders in their patients.
- Illustrate evidence-based treatment including therapy and prescribing psychiatric medications for patients, experiencing mental and behavioral health symptoms.
- Illustrate case-based learning to enhance the learning and understanding of behavioral health conditions as they are experienced by children and families in MI.
