**EXECUTIVE ORDER
CITY OF CAPE MAY**

On May 18, 2020, the City of Cape May issued an Executive Order restricting swimming on Cape May beaches until further notice.

This Executive Order rescinds the May 18, 2020, swimming restriction on Cape May beaches. Swimming will be permitted beginning at 10:00 a.m. on May 30, 2020.

Be further advised that the Cape May Beach Patrol will be on a pre-season modified duty schedule. Bathers must swim only when and where lifeguards are on duty.

The opening of the Cape May beaches for swimming shall be subject to all restrictions and strict social distancing requirements set forth in paragraphs 2 and 3 of New Jersey Executive Order 143.
