5 (15 U.S.C. 78w) is amended by adding at the end the fol6 lowing:

7 "(e) PROHIBITION ON REQUIRING AN ISSUER TO
8 MAKE CLIMATE-RELATED DISCLOSURES THAT ARE NOT
9 MATERIAL TO INVESTORS.—The Commission may not re10 quire an issuer to make climate-related disclosures that
