There will be one required team meeting prior to departure. You will receive the date once your application has been submitted and approved. A background check and Safe Sanctuary training are required to attend this trip.

WHY ARE WE GOING?

Red Bird Mission and Clinic have been providing ministries in the Appalachian Mountains since 1921. Red Bird serves an isolated, rural distressed area, handicapped by chronic poverty, lack of jobs, poor housing and obstacles due to the rugged mountain terrain. Red Bird Mission and Clinic strive to meet the needs of their community through education, health and wellness, community outreach, economic opportunity and community housing improvement.

Mt. Horeb will be coming alongside Red Bird Mission in a variety of ways, the most prominent by serving in their work camp, which will include light to heavy construction. We will also be helping in the community thrift store and serving in the Senior Center.

WHAT IS THE COST?

\$500

- Housing: volunteers stay in cabins (male and female cabins)
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner
- Project materials, transportation and tools

Unincluded expenses:

- Transportation to and from Red Bird; must take personal vehicles.
