Guidelines for Decorated Cars:

2. Each registered family will be allocated a total of 3 parking spaces – one designated parking space plus one space on either side of the designated space.
3. Families will have 1 hour to park and decorate, beginning at 6:00 p.m.
4. Families should assign one family member to stay with the car during the event; bring a chair to sit by your vehicle.
5. Cars can be decorated in various ways – front only, back only, or entire car.
6. Cars can be parked either facing out or facing in.
7. Themes must be family friendly and appropriate.
8. Decorations may include sound and lighting, but no electrical connections will be provided by the parish.
9. Candy, snacks, or drinks may not be handed out from cars.
10. Each family will have one hour to tear down and clean up their designated area at end of event.
11. Non-decorated vehicles must park in the lower GA parking lot.
12. Categories for prizes include: Best Theme, Most Creative, and Funniest.
