

Classroom Coordinators (ongoing) are responsible for planning class parties, collecting class fees and donations for teachers' gifts, and communicating important information to the class families as needed. (2 per class)

PTA Coke & Water Booth at Festival **(June)** : volunteers to work 2-3 hour shifts on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday

Bake Sales at the Fish Fry: (Lent) PTA organizes the Bake Sale at each Fish Fry during Lent. Volunteers are needed to supply the baked goods and to work the sale.

Used Uniforms PTA collects used outgrown uniforms from the GA families, then offers them "on Consignment" and returns the proceeds to the seller. The PTA will hold used uniform sales throughout the year and on an as needed basis. After Christmas Break, all unsold items will transfer to an exchange closet where GA families can leave items they no longer need, and pick up items that they need!

Penny Fair: February 1, 2019:

This is one of PTA's biggest fundraisers so any help is much needed.
