

**Guardian Angels School
Uniform Policy
2022-2023**

Guardian Angels School's uniform policy places an emphasis on modesty, cleanliness, and appropriate grooming. The presentation of our students is a symbol of the pride demonstrated at Guardian Angels School. Students are expected to be neat and presentable, therefore representing Guardian Angels School in a positive manner. Parents should be aware of appropriate apparel and overall appearance of their children prior to leaving for school each day.

The complete uniform must be worn on the first day of school. The administration has sole discretion in making final determinations about the regulations listed in the school's uniform policy. "Out of uniform" days are designated by the administration and only affect the type of clothing worn. All other regulations will be in effect on these days.

The Uniform Policy is part of the Code of Discipline. Students will receive a written warning for each uniform infraction. Three infractions will result in a disciplinary point and loss of subsequent out of uniform days.

Guardian Angels uniform items containing specific school plaid or logo, must be purchased from Schoolbelles, Lands End (tops only), Usports (tops only).

Primary Uniforms

Girls: Grades K-3

Jumper/Skirt

- Uniform plaid jumpers purchased from Schoolbelles or acquired through the school uniform exchange
- Jumpers may be worn at any time throughout the school year
- Ankle length leggings or tights in solid blue, black, or gray must be worn from December 1 to March 1

Boys and Girls: Grades K-3

Slacks/ Shorts

- Solid, navy blue or light khaki dress slacks
- Chino or "quick dry" material
- Slacks must be worn to the ankle and may not be rolled
- Must be worn on the waist
- No logos, colored stitching, decorations, or oversized pockets
- Solid, navy blue or khaki shorts are permitted. Shorts may be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee and no longer than 3 inches below knee length
- Slacks must be worn from December 1 to March 1

Shirts

- Red, navy, or white embroidered polo must be worn when the shirt is fully visible
- Solid red, navy or white polos without school logo may be worn under jumpers
- Long or short sleeve
- Must be tucked into pants or shorts throughout the school day
- No logo other than the Guardian Angels School logo may be visible on the shirts
- Short sleeve, white undershirts may be worn under the school polo (no colors or long sleeves)

Outerwear

- Official Guardian Angels School fleece in navy or red
- Official Guardian Angels School crew neck or 1/4 zip sweatshirt in navy or red (no hoodies)
- Collared polo style shirts must be visible beneath all uniform outerwear
- No other styles or spirit wear may be worn during the school day

Intermediate Uniforms

Girls: Grades 4-6

Skirt

- Uniform plaid blue skirts purchased from Schoolbelles or acquired through the school uniform exchange
- Former plaid uniform skirts will be grandfathered in for the 2022-2023 school year
- Skirts may be worn at any time throughout the school year
- Skirt length may be no higher than 3 inches above the knee
- Skirts may not be rolled at the waist.
- Ankle length leggings or tights in solid blue, black, or gray must be worn from December 1 to March 1

Boys and Girls: Grades 4-6

Slacks/ Shorts

- Solid, navy blue or khaki dress slacks
- Chino or “quick dry” material
- Slacks must be worn to the ankle and may not be rolled
- Must be worn on the waist
- No logos, colored stitching, decorations, or oversized pockets
- Solid, navy blue or khaki shorts are permitted. Shorts may be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee and no longer than 3 inches below knee length
- Slacks must be worn from December 1 to March 1

Shirts

- Red, Navy or white embroidered polo must be worn when the shirt is fully visible
- Long or short sleeve
- May have banded bottom
- Material may be cotton or sport wicking
- Shirts without banded bottom must be tucked in throughout the school day
- No logo other than Guardian Angels School logo may be visible on the shirts

Outerwear

- Official Guardian Angels School fleece
- Official Guardian Angels School crew neck or ¼ zip sweatshirt (no hoodies)
- Collared polo style shirts must be visible beneath all uniform outerwear
- No other styles or spirit wear may not be worn during the school day

Junior High School Uniforms

Girls: Grades 7-8

Skirt

- Uniform navy blue skirts purchased from Schoolbelles or acquired through the school uniform exchange
- Former plaid uniform skirts will be grandfathered in for the 2022-2023 school year
- Skirts may be worn at any time throughout the school year
- Skirt length may be no higher than 3 inches above the knee
- Skirts may not be rolled at the waist

Boys and Girls: Grades 7-8

Slacks/ Shorts

- Solid, navy blue or khaki dress slacks
- Chino or “quick dry” material
- Slacks must be worn to the ankle and may not be rolled
- Must be worn on the waist
- No logos, colored stitching, decorations, or oversized pockets
- Solid, navy blue or khaki shorts are permitted. Shorts may be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee and no longer than 3 inches below knee length

Shirts

- Red, Navy or white embroidered polo must be worn when the shirt is fully visible
- Long or short sleeve
- May have banded bottom
- Material may be cotton or sport wicking
- Shirts without banded bottom must be tucked in throughout the school day
- No logo other than the Guardian Angels School logo may be visible on the shirts

Outerwear- Only the following approved items may be worn during the school day

- Official Guardian Angels School fleece
- Official Guardian Angels School crew neck or ¼ zip sweatshirt
- Official Guardian Angels Junior High hoodie
- Collared polo style shirts must be visible beneath all uniform outerwear
- No other styles or spirit wear may be worn during the school day

Personal Appearance – Applies at all times.

Shoes

- Gym shoes must be worn throughout the school day
- Boots may be worn to school in inclement weather, but must be changed for the school day
- Sandals, clogs, open-toed shoes are not permitted

Socks

- Solid black, blue, or white must be visible above the shoe
- Logos may not be larger than 1 square inch
- Girls may wear solid white, navy, or black footed tights or ankle length leggings

Makeup

- Not permitted at any time.

Nails

- Nail polish is permitted
- No acrylic or artificial nails

Boys Hair

- Length should be above the collar and eyebrows
- Color must be natural
- May not cause interruptions of the learning environment

Girls Hair

- Length should be out of the eyes
- Color must be natural
- May not cause interruptions of the learning environment

Jewelry

- Piercing is permitted in the ears only
- Small button sized earrings only
- One small necklace
- One bracelet

Watches

- One watch may be worn
- Smart watches must be disconnected from cellular devices during the school day

Gym Uniform

- Gym shoes must be worn
- Approved GA gym shirt (sponsored by GA Boosters) and shorts only
- Items are expected to be washed weekly
- Must be purchased through USports
- All gym clothing should be labeled with student names

Out of Uniform and Spirit Days are designated by the administration and only affect the type of clothing worn. Unless otherwise announced, all out of uniform days will be “tops only.” Students are permitted to wear an out of uniform top with Guardian Angels approved uniform bottoms, sweatpants, or gym shorts. Sweatpants and shorts must be purchased through USports.

All other uniform regulations will be in effect on these days.

Spirit Day Policy

- Spirit wear days are tops only
- Top must contain the GA Logo or GA school colors – red, white, or navy
- Students may elect to wear school uniform bottoms, GA approved sweatpants (December 1 to March 1) or gym shorts (if “warm weather policy” is in place)
- Gym shoes must be worn.
- Makeup is not permitted

Out of Uniform Policy

- Students are to adhere to the dress code as announced by the school administration.
- Attire is expected to be appropriate and modest.
- Shorts may only be worn if the “warm weather uniform policy” is in effect. If worn, shorts may not be more than 3 inches above the knee.
- Leggings are considered undergarments. Any and all form fitting clothing should be worn beneath appropriate attire. (ie: tunic length tops, dresses, skirts, ect.)
- Spaghetti straps, midriff revealing shirts or open back tops are not permitted.
- Clothing with verbiage or depiction promoting association with a group or organization not conducive to the learning environment or teachings of the Catholic Church will not be permitted.
