POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the direction and supervision of the Child Development Director, the attendant will be responsible for planning, developing and implementing all program activities in the Child Watch area. The attendant guides the development of children, ensuring a safe, enriching and healthy environment. All employees must reflect the YMCA at ACRC core values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility when carrying out their job functions.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Administers the day to day operations of the Child Watch program, meeting all applicable state regulations and YMCA at ACRC policies.
2. Provides careful, attentive supervision, and is alert at all times.
3. Manages the program resources responsibly.
4. Facilitates a program environment that invites exploration, promotes positive play, and welcomes children.
5. Practices basic safety and health policies; guides children in eating habits, clean-up routines, bathroom habits and general development.
6. Completes required documentation (i.e. Incident Reports).
7. Maintains attendance sign in/out records and ensures Parents/Guardians are completing all sections of sign in/out sheets.
8. Ensures payment for Child Watch is taken care of at drop off.
9. Practices infection control procedures and proper hand washing.
10. Upholds the association's child protection policies, and child abuse and neglect guidelines, and proper reporting procedures.
11. Maintains a positive attitude toward children and their families.
12. Maintains confidentiality and treats all families with dignity and respect.
13. Completes Cleaning Checklist to ensure environment is kept neat and clean.
14. All other duties as assigned by Director

It is necessary to be able to pick a young child (baby) up off the ground and lay a young child (baby) down on the ground.
- Considered a light work position requiring exerting up to 30 pounds of force occasionally.
