School staff are concerned that some of their students will have difficulty accessing them and they've asked for The Family's help in communicating their need to the community. If you like to sew, then you can be *Sew Helpful* by sewing a few masks to stock their "Care Closets" for kids in need!

Where: 14 local school districts (so far) in our listening areas of Northeast, Central, and Southeast Wisconsin. Some school Districts include: Appleton, Chilton, De Pere, Elkhart Lake-Glenbeulah, Fond du Lac, Green Bay, Kaukauna, Menasha, Neenah, New London, Rosholt, Stevens Point, Waupaca, Wausau.

How: There are lots of great patterns and "how-to" videos on-line. Both pleated or Olson (cup style) are fine. All student sizes are needed, pre-school through high school. *Please don't forget the teens!* If you'd like to sew a some kid-friendly, student sized face masks we know some folks who could benefit from your talents!
