If your district is planning on using PowerScheduler to get your schedules ready for 2017-2018, the Prepare to Schedule workshop is mandatory to attend. This workshop walks schools through setting up the scenario for the next school year so schedules can be completed and students loaded into schedules before the end of the 16-17 school year.
