## KEYNOTE SPEAKER

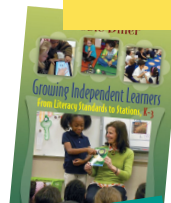
### Debbie Diller

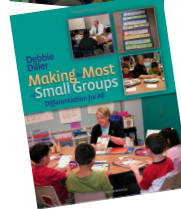
