We will continue to prioritize staying in consistent communication with participants for the weeks and months to come, to care for our students and keep our bonds of mentorship and support strong.

Maintaining Academic Excellence

Amidst change, our belief in our students' ability to be academically successful has remained steadfast. After ensuring our students have access to their remote academic materials and devices, we have begun hosting weekly group and individualized tutoring sessions via ZOOM (or the phone) to offer homework support. We remain in close contact with schools and teachers so that our organization can thoughtfully adapt over time to best ensure the well-being and academic success of our team members.

Collaborative Enrichment

First State Squash will continue with our literacy-based curriculum. One exciting

development. FSS is currently piloting a weekly collaboration with University of Delaware Professor, David Teague and his students to conduct a creative writing seminar for FSS students this Spring.
