The Al Forthan Scholarship has partnered with BottleDrop Give! Here's how you can help.



1. Pick up BottleDrop blue bags and tags from the MRC at 2318 NE MLK Jr. Blvd Portland, OR 97212
2. Fill the bags with Oregon deposit containers. Plastic, aluminum, and glass go in the same bags.
3. Bring your filled blue BottleDrop bags to the MRC or return them at any BottleDrop location. Up to 10 bags can be returned daily. The label on the blue bags will open the secure BottleDrop door.
