The Protect Our Children Protest is scheduled for THIS Friday, May 14th from noon until 2 pm. It was designed by Nebraskans Against Government Overreach (NAGO) whose leader is Allie French. NFFV asked Allie if we could share her plan with our members across Nebraska – and her answer was a resounding YES!

The goal is for parents to pull our children from their schools and all report to our respective school districts administration/board/etc. building for a **peaceful protest in support of an AMERICAN Education**; one without constant indoctrination. This building may be a school in some districts – please be mindful of any school activities occurring at this time and ensure we remain on public property without interfering with traffic (pedestrian and vehicular). We have a right to gather and peacefully protest on public property so long as we are respectful, peaceful and fully law abiding – these are all requirements of participating in NAGO Events.

This is a grassroots effort, which means it's success depends on us PARENTS! YOU must show up, YOU must recruit friends, family and neighbors to attend. One does not need to have children in the public-school setting. The public school system molds the minds of children that will one day join our society as, hopefully, productive citizens. Their methods, policies, values and so on AFFECT each and every one of us.
