
May 8th

She is the first blind contestant of MasterChef and the winner of its third season in 2012. She was the winner of Helen Keller Personal Achievement Award in 2014. In 2018, she opened a Vietnamese restaurant in Bravery Chef Hall in Houston, Texas named "The Blind Goat".

The most decorated figure skater in U.S. history, Michelle Kwan's skating accomplishments have earned her a place among the all-time greats of the sport. For over a decade, Kwan dominated the sport like no other skater in history, winning an unprecedented 43 championships, including five World Championships, nine U.S. National Championships and two Olympic medals. Kwan's activities off the ice have been equally noteworthy. In 2010, Ms. Kwan was elected to the Board of Directors of Special Olympics International.

Kamala D. Harris is the Vice President of the United States of America. She is the first woman, the first Black American, and the first South Asian American to be elected Vice President, as was the case with other offices she has held. She is, however, determined not to be the last.

Peter Gene Hernandez, known professionally as Bruno Mars, is an American singer, songwriter, record producer, musician, and dancer. He is known for his stage performances, retro showmanship, and for performing in a wide range of musical styles, including pop, R&B, funk, soul, reggae, disco, and rock. Bruno was born and raised in Honolulu, Hawaii, with his father from Puerto Rico and his mother from the Philippines.
