

** Haunted House, Carnival Games and Activities open throughout the night! **



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS TRUNK OR TREAT? This is an annual tradition at OLP! The 8th grade students work together as a class to create a safe, fun environment for children to Trick-or-Treat through the parking lot at family's vehicles - hence the name Trunk-or-Treat.

WHAT IS THE MONEY RAISED USED FOR? All of the money raised goes to support their final year festivities including the 8th Grade buddy program, graduation (everything from their farewell brunch to their caps and gowns) and their class gift back to the school.

WHAT IS DIFFERENT ABOUT THIS YEARS EVENT?

- In year's past we have sold a t-shirt with artwork from an 8th grader, but due to their limited wearing time and seasonality we are moving away from t-shirts. **Instead with a monetary donation of your choice there will be a dress down day (following school handbook guidelines) on Tuesday October 22nd.**
- There will be a new raffle this year for those that participate in purchasing/hosting parking spots. Every \$20 Admission will get you one ticket to win. Prizes will be given out the night of the event.
- Boo Bags have been upgraded to a reusable tote for Trick or Treating.

HOW DO I ORDER MY ITEMS? All items can be ordered online at [Trunk or Treat – OLP Spirit Store \(olpspiritshop.com\)](https://olpspiritshop.com). Take advantage of ordering ahead so you can focus on enjoying the evening with your family & friends! Pre-orders are due 10/18, with the exception of the Boo Bag which are due 10/14.

WHAT IS A BOO BAG? Boo Bags are special treat bags delivered to students on Wednesday 10/23. This year they will be a reusable Halloween tote with the artwork from an 8th grader. The bag will also have a craft, a few fun Halloween items and treats! This year we will have two different bags available for purchase; our standard bag and one that is more friendly to dietary/food allergy restrictions.

WHAT HAPPENS ONCE I ORDER AND SIGN UP? A parking spot will be assigned to you. During the ordering process, you may request to park with friends. Spots are limited and although we try to accommodate requests, we cannot guarantee you'll be parked next to your requested friend. The week of Trunk or Treat, your child will come home with a packet of items you purchased - parking pass, food vouchers, activity bands, etc.

WHAT IF I MISS THE DEADLINE TO ORDER? Due to the nature of pre-ordering food, prizes, and coordination involved; if you miss the deadline, you'll have the option to pay that night. There is a limited number of parking spots, if there are any available, you will be able to pay \$25 that night to park. You may also choose the "walk-in" option which is \$10 per person but does not provide a parking spot.

WHAT IF I NEED TO LEAVE EARLY? For the safety of the children walking through the parking lot, we ask that all cars wait until the end time to leave. If you know in advance you have to leave early, indicate such on the order form and ask to be slotted near an exit.

WHERE DO I PARK IF I AM A WALK IN Please park in the lots surrounding OLP or on the side streets. Note: the Presbyterian lot is reserved for 8th Grade families and other volunteers.
