Getting Ready to Register

Check your username and passwords now by making sure you can login to the www.nmyafl.org site.

If you experience difficulties registering your returning player, please contact the NMYAFL office by email or phone to make us aware of any issues or you can come to the NMYAFL Office to register directly.

Team Placement is not guaranteed. Upon team consolidation or if teams are full, your player may be moved to teams that have available space.

The Registration Process

<u>All Registrations are done Online</u>. Visit <u>www.nmyafl.org</u>. Login or create an account at the top right corner of the website (computer/tablet) or click the 3 lines on the left (phone) then click login or create account. Once logged in click the registration tile on the left.

Select football or cheer and enter your child's info and select the season they are participating in for this year.

If you need to register another child, click the + for football or cheer. Enter your child's information and click submit and complete payment process. You are finished once you get the big green checkmark.

Online Returning & New Player/Cheerleader Code Window January 31st through February 2nd

During the returning and new player/cheerleader code window Head Coaches will receive registration codes and can distribute them to their returning players/cheerleaders and or new players/cheerleaders who did not play in NMYAFL in the previous calendar year. These players/cheerleaders will only be allowed to register to the team associated with the code that was given to them by coach. Once registered they are locked on that team and cannot transfer

Online Open Registration and Returning Player with option to Transfer Window February 4th through June 30th In Person Fall Registration will close July 6th 2023

New Players or Players who wish to change teams must register during open registration. For new parents/players once registration is complete and you receive the green check mark you are done and should visit the what's next for new players in the parent portal on the website. For Players who wish to transfer teams, after receiving the green checkmark complete and submit the transfer form that can be found in the parent portal.

Transfer Information

*****Team Transfers are only available for Rookie 8U - Varsity 14U Divisions for 2023*****

All transfers must be submitted by June 30th at 2:00pm!

***** Team Transfer Requests during Open Registration *****

Returning Registered Fall Football Players who are in the *rookie, freshman, sophomore, junior or varsity age groups* may request to transfer from their existing team, and they can pick certain Teams for fall tackle football! But there are a few guidelines. Please see below:

- Players are not allowed to transfer to the last year's Division I Championship Team or Division I Runner Up and if submitted they will be denied immediately.
- Player MUST be a returning player from the previous fall season.
- Player **MUST** be registered for the current fall season first before the Team Transfer Request to a new team can be submitted.
- Team Transfer Request forms can be completed in the parent portal. Once submitted the form is timestamped and sent to the NMYAFL Office.
- Transfers are handled on a first come first served basis and are not guaranteed
- The requested team **MUST** have space available for your transfer to be completed.
- Players MUST be moving from an existing team to another existing team not the champion or runner up from the prior season.
- Players can only move to a team if the roster has reached the minimum of 12 players
 - Note --- New coaches creating new teams must find 12 new players and have them register directly to the new roster before any currently registered players or players registered in the prior season will be allowed to transfer to the new team's roster
- Team Transfer Forms will be available from February 3rd, the first open registration day through June 30th at 2:00 pm
- A Request is **NOT** a guarantee
- Request **MUST** be approved first before the move will be made. If approved, the record will be updated, and parents will receive an email confirmation.
- Mites 7U and Pee Wee 8U divisions are not allowed to submit a transfer form they must fill out a hardship in the office if they would like to move teams.

Tackle Football Programs

NMYAFL provides spring and fall tackle football for players ages 7 to 14. Our spring tackle football program consists of 6 regular season games and post season playoffs/championships. Players entering the 9th grade in the fall of the current year are not eligible to play Spring Tackle Football (please see the pre-high school 7 v 7 program). Our fall tackle football program consists of 8 regular season games and playoff/championships.

8 Man Tackle Football Programs

Mighty Mite (7U) USA Football Rookie Tackle - Both Seasons

USA Football's Rookie Tackle is part of the Football Development Model (FDM). It is small-sided (half a field) tackle football game designed to be implemented as a bridge between flag football and 11-on-11 tackle. The program includes many items that can help create an age-appropriate, athlete-centered experience. (Visit usafootball.com/rookietackle to learn more about this program)

Pee Wee (8U) 8 Man Tackle Football - Both Seasons

Our Pee Wee(8U) program brings more facets to the game by allowing special teams and 3-point stances while still embracing the 8-man model which includes smaller team rosters.

8- & 11-Man Tackle Football Program

Rookies (9U) to Varsity (14U) play 8-Man Tackle Football in the Spring & 11-Man Tackle Football in the Fall

All other age groups participate in 8-man tackle in the spring season & traditional 11-man tackle football with normal team roster sizes in the fall season.

The 8-Man Spring Season starts March 27th, 2023, and the 11-man Fall Season starts July 24th, 2023.

**** Mites 7U - Juniors 12U have a minimum play rule of 10 plays per game. ****
Coaches are required to make sure each player plays a minimum of 10 plays per game. There
is NO Minimum Play Rule for Varsity (14U) Teams.

NFL Flag Football Program

NMYAFL provides Spring NFL Flag for players ages 5 to 14 and Fall NFL Flag for players ages 5 to 7. Our Spring football program consists of 6 regular season games and post season playoffs/championships. The spring season starts March 27th, 2023, and fall starts July 24th, 2023.

Spring Pre-High School 7 v 7 Football Program

NMYAFL provides Spring Pre-high school 7 v 7 football for players ages 13-14 going into 9th grade this year. Our Spring football program consists of 6 regular season games and post season playoffs/championships. Players in pre-high school 7 v 7 receive a minimum 6 play per half of playing time. The spring season starts March 27th, 2023.

Cheer Program

NMYAC provides a spring and a fall cheer program for cheerleaders ages 5 to 14. Our spring cheer program consists of 6 regular season games/weekly sideline cheer and a cheer competition. Our fall cheer program consists of 8 regular season games/weekly sideline cheer and 2 cheer competitions. The spring season starts March 27th, 2022, and the fall season starts July 24th, 2023.

Upon team consolidation or if teams are full, your cheerleader may be moved to teams that have available space. There is no guarantee to cheer for siblings' team.

You can pay your child's registration in full at anytime. If you choose the payment plan option your initial payment is \$25.00 for any registration item. Balances must be paid in full before receiving equipment for football or being fitted for uniform for cheer. All Balances must be paid in full before June 1st 2023

Participant Balances must be paid in full in order to receive equipment or be fitted for cheer uniforms. For spring and fall combination registrations, Participant balances must be less than or equal to the amount indicated for combo registrations.



Football and Cheer Programs at a glance



Season Dates

- **Spring** season starts March 27th and continues through May 21st, 2023. Spring Championships are May 21st, 2023
- **Fall** season starts July 24th and continues through October with playoffs. Superbowl Championships are October 29th, 2023.
- Regular season games are held on Saturdays and are played at Mesa Del Sol, Rio Rancho Sports Plex, CNM West Campus and Los Lunas Heritage Park fields.
- Playoff Games are held on Sundays and are played in local stadiums.

Football Program

Tackle

- Ages 7 14 (League age is child's age on July 31st of current year).
- Age Groups: Mighty Mites 7yr old's(7U), Pee Wee- 8yr old's(8U). Rookies- 9yr old's(9U), Freshman- 10yr old's(10U), Sophomores- 11yr old's(11U), Juniors- 12yr old's(12U), Varsity- 13-14yr old's(14U).
- Teams are divided by age and high school district.
- Upon team consolidation or if teams are full, your player may be moved to teams that have available space.
- Tackle registration fee includes the helmet, shoulder pads, jersey, pants and mouthpieces.
- Fall Practices are 2 hours, 5 days a week the first 2 weeks, then goes to 4 days a week. Spring season practice only 3 days week. Practice times are determined by coach but are usually between 5:30-7:30pm.
- 6 games in Spring, 8 games in Fall with the possibility of playoff game(s)
- Players entering the 9th grade in the fall of the current year are not eligible to play Spring Football (please see the pre-high school 7 v 7 program).
- <u>Mites 7U Juniors 12U have a minimum 10 plays per game rule.</u> Coaches are required to make sure each player plays a minimum of 10 plays per game in all divisions. In addition, <u>there is NO Minimum Play Rule for all Varsity (14U) Teams.</u>

Tackle Football Equipment Deposit

- Each new player or a returning player who returned their equipment after December 1st must submit a \$75 deposit to receive a helmet and or shoulder pads from NMYAFL.
- Every Varsity (13U+) level player must submit a \$75 equipment deposit prior to receiving equipment.
- The equipment deposit is an incentive to return the equipment prior to December 1st of the current year. It is not meant to be replacement cost of the equipment.

NFL Flag Football

- Passing Primarily
- Ages 5-14 (League age is child's age on July 31st of current year).
- Includes NFL Game Jersey and Flags
- Practices are limited (2) two-hour practices or 4 hours max weekly
- Spring 6 games and Fall 8 games
- Teams are divided by ages 6U, 8U, 10U, 12U and 14U.

Spring Pre-High School 7 v 7 Football

- Ages 13-14 (League age is child's age on July 31st of current year).
- Only available for those entering high school in the fall of the current year
- Includes 7 v 7 jersey, soft 7 v 7 helmet and mouthpiece
- Practices are limited (2) two-hour practices or 4 hours max weekly
- 6 games
- Teams are divided by high school district

Cheer Program

- Registration fee includes the uniform and poms
- Cheerleaders ages 7 14 (League age is child's age on July 31st of current year).
- Junior Cheerleaders ages 5 and 6 (League age is child's age on July 31st of current year).

 Junior Cheerleaders do not participate in stunting or the Fall Cheer-Fest Competition.
- Spring Seasons consist of sideline game-day cheer and one cheer competition
- Fall Season consists of sideline game-day cheer and two cheer competitions.
- Teams are divided by high school district.
- Teams are comprised of multiple age groups.
- Upon team consolidation or if teams are full, your cheerleader may be moved to teams that have available space. There is no guarantee to cheer for siblings' team.
- Spring practices are 5 days a week the first week, then goes to 3 days a week. Fall practices are 5 days a week the first 2 weeks, then goes to 3 days a week. Practice times are determined by coach but are usually between 5:30-7:30pm.
