



P2P Partners with GVRA

Parent to Parent of Georgia (P2PGA) is partnering with Georgia Vocation Rehabilitation Agency on a project focused on improving employment outcomes for youth with disabilities. This project is called Career Pathways to Work: Explore, Engage and Employ or the “E3 Project.

The E3 project is being piloted in several Georgia school districts during the 2016-17 school year and P2PGA has hired Transition Partners to work with these districts. Transition Partners are available to assist families with transition, education and healthcare issues. In addition to providing one-on-one assistance, they are matching families to Supporting Parents, connecting them to providers from our database and providing reading and resource materials from our Virtual Library. They will also be working with local VR and school staff to coordinate training, and educational sessions on transition topics.

Transition Partners have completed Parent to Parent orientation and training and have been meeting with VR and school staff to determine the needs of families in each district. They are busy attending transition fairs and community gatherings and have been sharing information and resources with families. We expect 2017 will be a busy year for our Transition Partners!
