

Status Report, Holy Cross Reopening Plan

The Holy Cross Reopening Plan is currently in the “2nd Draft” stage. The draft is under review by the three members of the working group. When the final draft is completed it will be submitted to the Vicar and Senior Warden for their concurrence, from there it will be presented for approval to the Bishop’s Committee. Final approval, required before reopening, will come from the Diocese.

The governing guidance for the plan comes from two primary sources, our Diocesan Bishop, and the California Department of Public Health. Supplemental guidance has also been received from the County of San Diego. There have been numerous updates to the guidance we’ve received, and the working group is ensuring that all applicable guidance is followed in the Holy Cross Reopening Plan. The plan will be quite specific with regards to the many tasks required of ministry leaders before in-person worship may resume.
